## DRESDEN FAN

1. Sew together (2) F and (1) D wedges to make a left quarter Dresden Fan. Repeat using (2) D and (1) $\mathbf{F}$ wedges to make a right quarter Dresden Fan. Sew the two fan units together.
2. Curve-piece the fan to (1) $\mathbf{G}$ half-circle. Turn under the outer seam allowance of points of each wedge, and appliqué fan unit to (1) $\mathbf{K} 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make (8) half Dresden fan units.

Place square, right sides together, on a corner of (1) B 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from drawn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{K}$ corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{K}$ square at the other corner of same $\mathbf{B}$ rectangle to complete (1) Flying Geese Unit. Make (2).

10. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top, and (1) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of a Flying Geese Unit.
11. Sew together (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Add to the bottom of sewn unit made in Step 10.
12. Sew together (1) B 1-1/2" square, (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and (1) $\mathbf{B} \mathbf{1 "}^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
13. Add (1) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of the unit made in Step 12, measuring 3" square unfinished.
14. Add (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the left side of Step 13 unit, followed by (1) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

18. Sew (2) $\mathbf{D} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) $\mathbf{K} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
19. Add (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top, and (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of the Step 18 sewn unit. Make (2) columns.
20. Sew columns to the opposite sides of sewn unit made in Step 17 as shown. Make (2) Fence Blocks.

32. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K}$ T2 and (1) $\mathbf{K}$ T3 triangle to (1) $\mathbf{B} T 1$ triangle. Add (2) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides, measuring 2-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

33. Corner Triangles: Follow Step 23 using (2) K $1^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) E 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Add (2) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the left and right sides.

34. Repeat Step 33 using (2) $\mathbf{K} 1^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) $\mathbf{F} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, adding (2) $\mathbf{K} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides.

Repeat one more time using (2) $\mathbf{K} 1^{\prime \prime}$ square and (1) B 2-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, adding (2) K 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides.

35. Sew units made in Steps 32-34 together. Add (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of sewn unit, followed by (1) A 1-1/2"x 8-1/2" rectangle to the bottom.
36. Sew together (2) A 1-1/2" squares, (2) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. ## BORDERS

42. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $\mathbf{K} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
43. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) J $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) J 2-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
44. Inner Border 3: Sew (2) K $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 65-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
45. Outer Border: Sew together (2) C $3^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) C $3^{\prime \prime} \times 55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom complete quilt top.
