## Bejeweled Quilt - by Maywood Studio

Please read all instructions before you begin. All seam allowance is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise stated.

## Assemble the A Blocks

1. Sew a (Fabric 8) B strip to either side of a Fabric 1 A-square. Press away from center.

2. Sew a (Fabric 8) C strip to the top and bottom of the step 1 unit. Press

3. Sew a (Fabric 1) D strip to either side of step 2 unit. Press

4. Sew a (Fabric 1) E strip to the top and bottom of the step 3 unit. Press

5. Sew a (Fabric 8) E strip to either side of the step 4 unit. Press

6. Sew a (Fabric 8) F strip to the top and bottom of the step 5 unit. Press


A Block

$12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
7. Repeat steps 1-6 to make these A-Blocks:


Fabric 2 and 10 Make 4


Fabric 3 and 9 Make 3


Fabric 2 and 7 Make 2

## Assemble the B Blocks

8. Sew a (Fabric 2) D strip to either side of a Fabric 4 H -strip. Press

9. Sew a (Fabric 2) J strip to the top and bottom of the step 8 unit. Press

10. Sew a (Fabric 4) K strip to either side of the step 9 unit. Press

11. Sew a (Fabric 4) L strip to the top and bottom of the step 10 unit. Press


B Block


Make 3
$6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12. Repeat steps 8-11 to make these B Blocks:


Fabric 11 and 5 Make 5


Fabric 1 and 6 Make 4


Fabric 2 and 7 Make 4
13. Sew the A Blocks and B Blocks into pairs as shown. Press seams open. Set aside the remaining four B Blocks.

15. Arrange the A-B Block pairs and the remaining B-Blocks into the sections as shown. Sew the pairs together into the sections as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows.

16 Sew the sections together as shown. Press seams open.

17. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired.
18. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise.
19. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance, mitering the corners. Trim the excess backing and batting, then turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
